

## Guidelines for E-Poster Presentation

- E-poster must be a **single slide** in PowerPoint (.ppt/.pptx) format and oriented in **landscape**.
  - **Screen resolution** should be 1920×1080 (or 20×11.25 inches).
- The e-poster text should contain the following sections:
  - Introduction
  - Objective
  - Methods
  - Results
  - Discussion
  - Conclusion
  - References
- Illustrations, images, and photographs must be large enough to clearly present relevant details.
  - Animations, movies, and sounds are **not supported**.
- Presentation file size must not exceed **20MB**.
- Only the **presenter's name** is to be included on the poster.
  - Names of co-authors and the institute must remain **anonymous**.
- E-posters will be displayed for a specified duration, determined by the Scientific Committee.
- **Discussion sessions** may be conducted after e-poster displays, similar to oral presentations, and led by an appointed chairperson/co-chairperson.
- Presenting authors will receive certificates from the chairperson and co-chairperson at the session's conclusion.
